About Webinar:

NEP 2020 highlighted on Social Justice and Empowerment, barrier-free access for children with special needs into the education and recommends a series of policies and schemes. In this background, there is a need, to discuss and deliberate on the various needs and challenges of the special children, especially those of the hearing impaired children.

A Two - Day Webinar therefore is organized on “Speech and Hearing Impairment- Issues & Remedies” to bring out the relevant schemes, remedies, treatments and concerns by the experts in the concerned fields. Hearing Impairment is one of the most common disabilities in the Human Population and presents a great risk in everyday life due to problems with speech recognition, communication and language acquisition. Due to hearing impairment, the internal representation of the acoustic stimuli is degraded. This causes difficulties that are experienced commonly by hearing impaired listeners, as speech recognition requires the acoustic signal to be correctly decoded.

In addition, in daily life speech is often heard among a variety of sounds and noisy backgrounds that can make communication even more challenging. Hearing impaired listeners suffer more from such adverse conditions in terms of speech perception performance as compared with normal hearing listeners.

The aim of the programme is to familiarize the Teachers and Researchers through live interactive sessions about the various areas i.e. Speech and Hearing Therapies, Occupational therapies, Strategies, Causes and Preventive measures for hearing impairment.

Government Teachers, Private Teachers, Trainee Teachers, Students and Research Scholars.
