## **Agenda, Item- I**

### **Status of Autonomy**

The first phase of autonomy expired by 2012. On the basis of the report of the UGC Expert committee and on the basis of the recommendations of the standing committee, the commission at a meeting held on 07.10.2015 decided to grant extension of autonomous status to Andhra Mahila Sabha College of Teacher Education, under the UGC scheme for autonomous colleges, for a period of six years w.e.f.2015-2016 to 2020-2021 including Expost fact approval from the year 2013-2014 to 2014-2015.

### **Status of NAAC**

To quote UGC “ In case of expiry of accreditation cycle the college seeking extension of autonomous status must submit a proof of having applied for accreditation by NAAC to be eligible for extension of autonomy. Therefore you are requested to submit the same”However, as college failed to submit the proof UGC did not grant extension of autonomy.

On approaching NAAC, college was advised to submit AQARS retrospectively from 2017 onwards. College submitted all the AQARS, till 2021-2022.
