- **Dr Jhansi principal of Arts and Science College AMS** gave many Valuable inputs on the need to strengthen the unaided section of the college

In the light of NAAC Peer Team Visit, she explained in detail, the precautions to be taken by the college on Hostel facilities, quality and variety of food Served to the, resident students. She cautioned the College, that NAAC is more interested to interact with students on most of the seven criteria.

She spoke about introduction of many new courses, in her college like MA. In English Literature, B. SC Honours in Computers, etc, she also mentioned that their college was in the fourth cycle of NAAC accreditation.

- **Dr. Jyothi Victoria, Alumna and Academic In-Charge of Alumni Council** gave some valuable inputs to improve the Quality of Academics especially in the comprehension of course content i.e. Teaching learning, in the courses offered by the college.

In her speech she, spoke about the founder of the NGO, who was both deaf and dumb. She narrated the circumstances under which she made this foundation happen and explained her struggle and efforts to develop her NGO.

She spoke on the expansion of her activity that spread over 9 branches with 72 staff members and 420 students.

She mentioned that special training is being offered by her, to the deaf and dumb students, in communication skills, to be able to fetch good placements, in corporate companies like, Tech Mahindra, Accenture, Wipro foundation and Small industries.

Mrs Ramya informed that in the current scenario, there is huge demand for differently abled candidates, as they are recruited by many corporate, companies and Banks

Spoke about their efforts to develop a curriculum on the lines suggested by NEP for the Holistic development of Aanganwadi and Pre primary students.
