A) Institution

For the overall experience of the students in the institution, 50% reported excellent and 42% reported 'good'. Similarly, for most of the areas, 80-90% students' reported excellent and good. The three areas in which reported % which is above average are ambience, infrastructure facilities and administrative functioning. Continuous efforts are made to improve these areas.
