TRAINING ON "INNOVATIVE TEACHING METHODS Pedagogy is the heart of teaching and learning. The pedagogy needs to connect the concept along with real life situation, this should promote lifelong learning through classroom transaction, also promote various social skills in to the classroom. Considering these immediate concerns, College of teacher Education Andhra Mahilasabha organised aprogram "**TRAINING ON "INNOVATIVE TEACHING METHODS** on 29.09.2020 and 30.09.2020 to incorporate the innovative methods of teaching in daily classroom.

RUMINATION- SELF EXPLORATION THROUGH ART AND DRAMA.

Teachers take a leading role in designing and implementing classroom experiences that foster creativity. Teachers need to have a deep understanding of cognitive mapping and be able to relate one idea to another so that they can address misconceptions and teach learners according to standards. Teaching strategies need to be viewed as cross-disciplinary. The use of drama and art in education leads to holistic learning, accelerates personality development, cooperation and collaboration. In view of this college of teacher education, Andhra Mahila Sabha, recognized the urge of including the art and drama at the high end.
