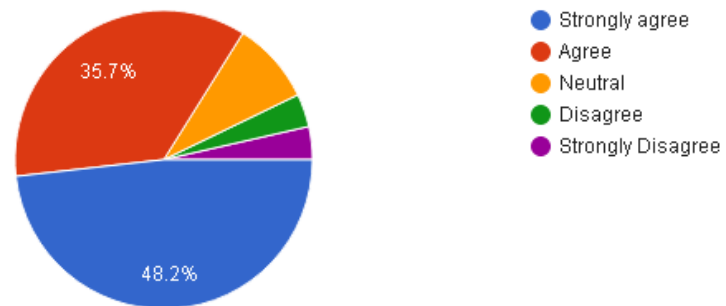

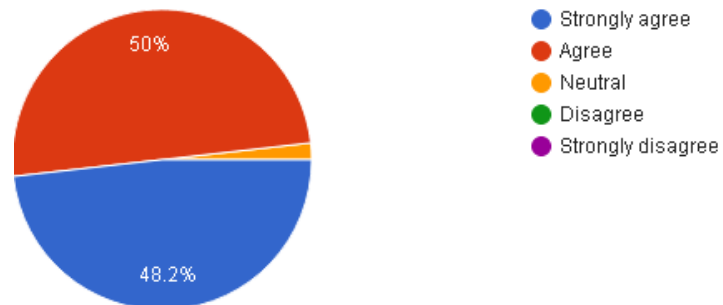

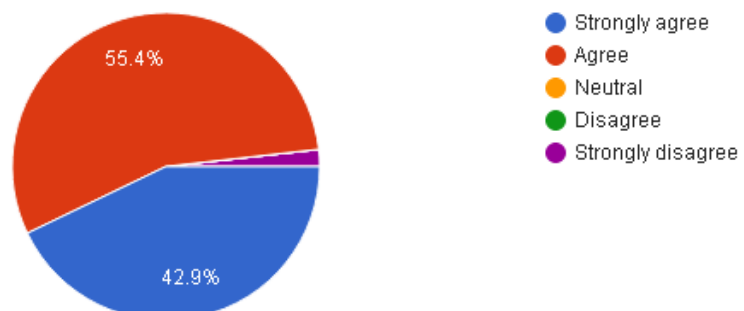

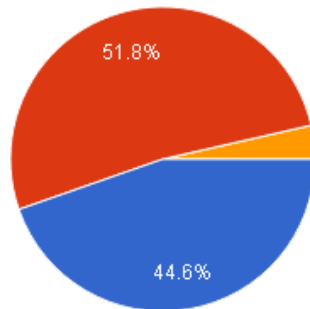

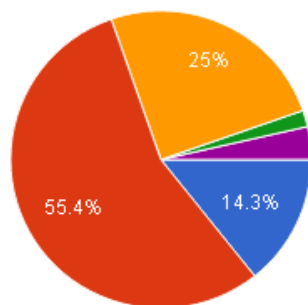

18 Percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching

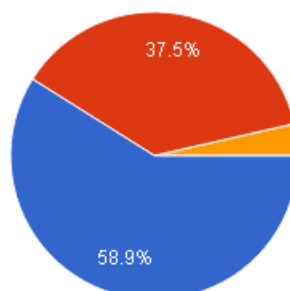
